

### Damai CCA Policy

- > CCA is compulsory
- Most CCAs are conducted on either <u>Mondays</u> and/or <u>Thursdays</u>. (Extra training during peak seasons on Wednesday)
- Students who miss CCA miss out on an integral part of the school experience where strong friendships are forged and character is built




### Online CCA Selection

- You will need your <u>MIMS details</u> to login







#### Important Note:

- 1. You must choose at least one Uniformed Group (UG) in your top 6 CCA choices
  - NCC (boys);
    - Girl Guides (girls); or
    - NPCC (boys / girls)
- Do not select CCA that are gender specific if you are of the opposite gender. i.e. Girls should not select Rugby (boys only). These choices will be deemed invalid.
